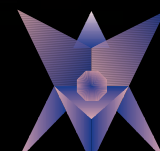

## NAME CHANGES

# PHALAENOPSIS 'MOTH ORCHIDS'

## The Beginner's Choice and An Ideal Gift!

One of the most popular orchids grown as houseplants are the **Moth Orchids** or **Phalaenopsis**. They make good indoor plants because they can tolerate the drier heat of central heating as well as having extremely long-lasting flowers at any time of the year. They do not have bulbs like other orchids but instead grow with fleshy leaves, new ones formed from the central crown. They also produce a lot of aerial roots that come over the side of the pot as well as into the bark compost.

**TEMPERATURE:** Moth Orchids love the warmth of most modern homes, keep a minimum on winter nights of 18°C (65°F), with a daytime maximum of 30°C (85°F).

**LIGHT:** Keep shaded from bright, direct summer sun as this can scorch the leaves. Give as much light as possible during the dull winter months.

**WATERING:** Keep the free-draining bark compost moist all the year round. When watering the plant, remove it from any cover pot or saucer, pour water through the pot and then let it drain before placing it back in a decorative planter. Never let the pot stand in water. Allow the compost to dry out slightly and the pot to become lighter before watering again. Avoid water collecting in the crown of the plant as this can cause a rot. Add a little orchid fertiliser to the water as directed all year round.

**RE-FLOWERING:** When your Moth Orchid has just one or two flowers left on the initial spray, cut the stem back to just above the highest eye on the flower stem. This eye will then start to grow and produce a side branch of flowers usually within a couple of months (see picture right). A brand new flower stem can also be produced from the base of the plant by cutting the original stem right back to the base.

**BRASSIA CHIEFTAIN** young plants £7.00 near flowering size £12.00  
(longissima x verrucosa) Arching sprays of long, spidery flowers coloured in shades of green. Fragrant. Summer flowering. Cool-intermediate. (see photo)

**BULBOPHYLLUM JERSEY** young plants £7.00 flowering size £15.00  
(lobbii x echninobabium) Unusual flowers in rich pinkish red with long, curved petals, Intermediate. (see photo)

**BULBOPHYLLUM VALLEY ISLE QUEEN** young plants £10.00 flowering size £15.00  
(Jersey x echninobabium) Extra long petals are expected from this next generation cross. Intermediate.

**CIRRHOPELALUM ELIZABETH ANN 'BUCKLEBURY' AM/RHS-AOS** young plants £10.00  
(longissimum x rothschildianum) This superb hybrid has pendent spikes with pink flowers with very long sepals. Long-lasting. Summer. Grow suspended in good light. Intermediate. (see photo)

(mooreana x lawrenceana) Divisions from our awarded clone will produce stunning, large cream flowers with the rich orange and brown throat held on tall stems. Cool with winter rest.

(fragrans x speciosa) Pale yellow and apricot shades are expected from this cross, the flowers could also be scented. Cool-intermediate.

**COELOGYNE TAICA** young plants £7.00  
(lawrenceana x speciosa) Good sized flowers in peach and apricot shades with a dark brown lip. Cool-intermediate.

**ODONTONIA DEBUTANTE 'OXBOW'** young plants £7.00  
Tall branched stem of flowers with brown and green petals, the lip in contrasting white and maroon. Cool. (see photo)

**PHRAGMIPEDIUM GRANDE** £30.00  
(longifolium x caudatum) Large flowers with long, dangling petals. Shades of green with slight spotting inside the lip. Summer flowering. Warm.

**PHRAGMIPEDIUM PULCHELLUM** near flowering size £15.00  
(Grande x Sedenii) A modern remake of this old hybrid will give us large flowers with long petals in shades of deep rose-pink, highly spotted on the inside of the lip. Warm.

**THUNIA GATTONENSIS** £20.00  
(winniana x majorensis) Tall canes with annual soft leafy growth produce a cluster of large, papery white & pink flowers from the top. Deciduous. Summer. Cool with winter rest. (see photo)

**WILSONARA WIDECOMBE FAIR 'BURNHAM'** young plants £7.00

**AERIDES HOULLETIANA** £25.00  
Long, densely packed pendent stem of fleshy flowers, yellow with a pink lip, fragrant. Thailand/Vietnam. Intermediate.

**AERIDES ODORATA** £15.00  
Flowers tipped with rosy purple on long pendulous sprays. Sweet fragrance. Summer flowering. India. Intermediate/warm.

**AERIDES ROSEA** £15.00  
(syn. *Aerides fieldingii*) Densely packed stems of 20-25 rose-pink flowers. Fragrant. Spring/summer. Vietnam/Thailand. Warm.

**ANGULOA CLOWESII** £30.00  
Known as the 'tulip orchid' because of the large, tulip-shaped flowers in bright, golden yellow. Strongly scented. Spring/summer. Colombia/Venezuela. Cool with deciduous winter rest. (see photo)

**ARPOPHYLLUM GIGANTEUM** £15.00 large £25.00  
Single, long, leathery leaves from a thick stem-like pseudobulb. The flower spike gives a 'bottle-brush' effect with numerous tiny bright pink flowers packed tightly together. Central America. Warm.

**ASPASIA LUNATA** £12.00  
Single, starry-shaped flowers in bold brown and green with a pinky-white lip. Brazil. Summer flowering. Intermediate. (see photo)

**BARBOSELLA AUSTRALIS** £12.00  
Miniature growing as a creeping mat of leaves, singular tiny bright green-yellow flowers are held on long thin stems. Brazil. Cool.

**BIFRENARIA HARRISONIAE** £15.00  
1-2 large flowers at the base of the plant, creamy white with dark red hairy lip. Fragrant. Spring. Brazil. Cool with winter rest. (see photo)

**BRASSIA VERRUCOSA** £15.00  
Known as the "Spider Orchid" with its long, thin petals, apple green with the white lip spotted in dark green. Very showy. Fragrant. Summer. Mexico. Cool - Intermediate. (see photo)

**BULBOPHYLLUM ECHINOLABIUM** young plants £7.00  
Large, long-petalled flowers, one at a time on a tall stem. Deep purple/red with bright red lip. Strongly scented. Borneo. Warm. (see photo)

**CATLEYA FORBESII** young plants £7.00 flowering size £12.00  
Waxy flowers with narrow yellow/olive-green petals and sepals. The narrow lip is white with a yellow throat, often with a rose flush. Autumn. Brazil. Intermediate.

**CATLEYA LABIATA** young plants £7.00  
2-5 large 7" pale rosy-pink flowers. Lip same with a magenta-purple margin and yellow throat. Brazil. intermediate. (see photo)

**CATLEYA QUADRICOLOR** young plants £7.00  
Large white, showy blooms tinted with lilac, the frilled petals projecting forwards. The lip is also white with yellow and purple. Fragrant. Winter. Colombia. Intermediate.

**CHYSIS AUREA** £20.00  
Large, waxy yellow flowers with orange markings. Central America. Intermediate.

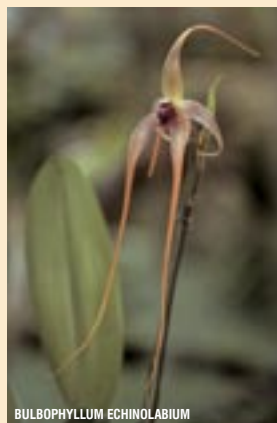
**CIRRHAEA DEPENDENS** £12.00  
Pendent stem of many waxy, long lasting flowers, olive green and deep purple barring, upside-down. Spring/summer. Brazil. Intermediate.

# ORCHID SPECIES

**COELIA BELLA** £20.00

Many showy flowers are clustered around the base of the pseudobulbs, in white and yellow with rose-purple tips to the petals. Fragrant. Central America. Intermediate.

**COELOGYNE BARBATA** £15.00

Medium sized white flowers on a tall stem, the lip coloured with a brown, bearded fringe. Spring. India. Cool, rest in winter. (see photo)

**COELOGYNE CRISTATA** near flowering size £10.00

Frosty white flowers of good size, eye catching yellow streak in the throat. Always in great demand. Spring flowering. India. Very cool with winter rest. (see photo)

**COELOGYNE CRISTATA VAR. ALBA** £12.00

Large white flowers, no yellow lip. Spring flowering. India. Cool with winter rest. (see photo)

**COELOGYNE DAYANA** young plants £12.00

Many pale yellow flowers on a long, pendent stem, lip white with chocolate-brown veining. Summer. South East Asia. Intermediate.

**COELOGYNE FIMBRIATA** £10.00

Short creeping plant, flowers buff coloured, solitary, lip dark brown. Autumn. India. Cool. (see photo)

**COELOGYNE FLACCIDA** £15.00

Short pendent spikes of cream-white flowers with golden yellow and orange-brown markings on the lip. Fragrant. Winter/spring. India. Cool with winter rest. (see photo)

**COELOGYNE FULIGINOSA** £10.00

This is similar to *Coelogyne fimbriata* but grows larger. Succession of buff flowers from the top of the pseudobulb, lip is darker. Thailand and Burma. Autumn flowering. Cool with winter rest. (see photo)

**COELOGYNE FUSCESCENS** £10.00

Pale yellow flowers with large deep brown lip. Similar to *C. fimbriata*, but with a more climbing habit. India. Autumn. Cool with winter rest.

**COELOGYNE OCHRACEA** £15.00

Sparkling white flowers on compact stems. Lip marked with yellow and margined orange. Fragrant. Spring flowering. India. Very cool with winter rest. (see photo)

**COELOGYNE MASSANGEANA** £30.00

Long, pendent stems with many yellow blooms, the lip patterned with brown and white. Fragrant. Summer. Malaysia. Intermediate. (see photo)

**COELOGYNE SPECIOSA** £20.00

Short, arching sprays of large flowers produced in succession. The petals and sepals are coloured apricot to the contrasting lip in creamy-white with deep orange-brown markings. Autumn/winter. Borneo, Sumatra. Cool-intermediate.

**COELOGYNE SPECIOSA VAR. SALMONICOLOR** £20.00

This variety has no brown markings on the lip, instead the whole flower is coloured salmon-pink. Autumn/winter. Borneo/Sumatra. Cool-intermediate.

**COELOGYNE TRIPLICATULA** £10.00

Similar in habit to *C. fuliginosa* with tawny flowers in succession from the top of the pseudobulb, the lip is more hairy though. Autumn. South East Asia. Cool with winter rest.

Pendent stem of small yellow flowers, tinged with red. Fleshy leaves. Autumn flowering. Thailand. Warm. (see photo)

## CYMBIDIUM DAYANUM

young plants £10.00  
Pendent, short sprays of creamy-white flowers also striped in red. Winter. Thailand, Philippines. Cool.

## CYMBIDIUM DEVONIANUM

£20.00  
Pendent sprays of pretty reddish brown flowers. Spring flowering. Himalayas. Cool growing with winter rest. (see photo)

## CYMBIDIUM EBURNEUM

£15.00  
Large single or paired white flowers with a touch of yellow in the centre. India, Nepal, China. Winter flowering. Cool with winter rest. (see photo)

## CYMBIDIUM ERYTHROSTYLUM

young plants £7.00  
The large, showy blooms have pure white petals and sepals, the petals thrust forward over the lip which is coloured white and yellow with bold red veining. Autumn. Vietnam. Cool. (see photo)

## CYMBIDIUM MASTERSII

Leafy cane-like pseudobulbs with bright purple & white flowers. Spring. India. Cool with winter rest.

## DENDROBIUM PIERARDII

Cream and pink flowers along the length of the long canes. South East Asia. Cool. Rest in winter. On bark.

## DENDROBIUM SPECIOSUM

Long, arching spikes laden with many yellow/creamy-white flowers, the lip dotted in purple/red. Fragrant. Autumn. Australia, New Guinea. Cool. (see photo)

## DENDROCHILUM COBBIANUM

Long chain-like sprays of many tiny creamy-white flowers, fragrant. Winter/spring. Philippines. Cool - Intermediate. (see photo)

Long pendulous habit, single flowered stems of pale green and purple spotted miniature blooms. Central and South America. Intermediate. On bark.

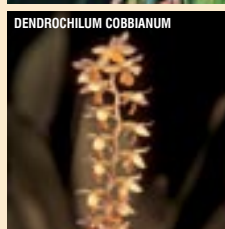

## **EPIDENDRUM CENTROPETALUM**

young plants £7.00

Clusters of long-lasting lavender pink flowers at the top of a reed stem growth. Winter flowering. Intermediate. (see photo)

## **EPIDENDRUM LATILABRE**

young plants £10.00

Clusters of green flowers are produced from the end of the latest growth - tall, upright habit. Spring/summer. Brazil. Intermediate. (see photo)

## **EPIDENDRUM PEPEROMIA**

£12.00

Miniature with creeping habit. Singular waxy green and burgundy, glossy flowers low to the foliage. Winter. American Tropics. Intermediate. (see photo)

## **GOMESA CRISPA**

£12.00

Compact growing with dainty sprays of 'green little men', fragrant. Autumn flowering. Brazil. Cool - Intermediate.

## **GONGORA GALEATA VAR. ALBA**

£12.00

Albino form where the flowers are a pale greeny-yellow all over hanging on a pendent stem. Fragrant. Summer. Guatemala. Cool.

## **GONGORA TRUNCATA**

£15.00

Grows well in a basket with its pendent spike hanging down with many small cream and red speckled flowers. Fragrant. Summer. Mexico. Cool. (see photo)

## **LEPANTHOPSIS ASTROPHOREA 'STALKY'**

£12.00

Probably the smallest orchid flower in this catalogue! Miniature plants only reaching 4-5cm high with thin flower spikes from the newest leaves producing exquisite tiny purple flowers on sprays which are almost perpetually flowering. Central and South America. Cool.

## **LEPTOTES UNICOLOR**

Real miniature with short, thick leaves and flowers coming from the base of the leaves. They range pale rose-lilac to white. Winter. Brazil. Intermediate.

## **LIPARIS NUTANS**

young plants £10.00

Sprays of many small pretty reddish-orange flowers. Autumn flowering. Philippines. Intermediate. (see photo)

## **LYCASTE DEPPEI**

young plants £7.00

Showy, singular flowers from the base of the plant. The pointed sepals are mottled in green and brown with a brighter yellow lip and contrasting white petals. Spring. Mexico. Cool. Deciduous with winter rest.

## **LYCASTE VIRGINALIS**

young plants £7.00

Superb, large pale pink flowers from the base of the plant with a deep pink centre. Spring. Mexico. Cool. Deciduous with winter rest. (see photo)

## **MALAXIS LATIFOLIA 'FRISKY'**

Compact plant, soft-leaved with tall flower spike from centre of pseudobulb. Many tiny purple flowers all along stem. Deciduous. India. Summer flowering. Intermediate with winter rest. (see photo)

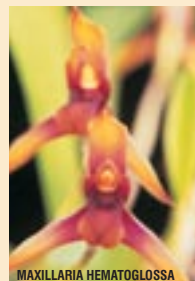

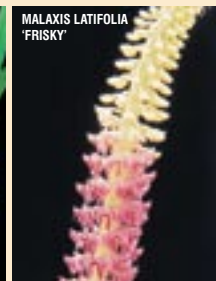

## MAXILLARIA PRAESTANS

£12.00

Free flowering, with dark attractive flowers. Yellowish to red brown, lined and dotted with dark brown. Lip black. Various flowering times. Central America. Cool. (see photo)

## MAXILLARIA TENUIFOLIA 'RED'

young plants £7.00

Plant has an upward but compact growing habit with long, thin leaves. Short-stemmed, single flowers are red with white on the lip also. Fragrant. Summer. Honduras. Cool. (see photo)

## MILTONIA CLOWESII

near flowering size £12.00

Showy flowers on a tall stem, chestnut - brown and yellow petals with a white lip and centre in purple. Autumn. Brazil. Cool - Intermediate.

## MILTONIA FLAVESCENS

£12.00

Tall sprays of large star-like, straw-yellow blooms are held above the pale foliage. Fragrant. Brazil, Paraguay. Intermediate with shade.

## MILTONIA REGNELLII

£20.00

Petals white with pale rose blush. Lip pale rose streaked with rose/purple & yellow. Brazil. Intermediate.

## NEOLAUCHEA PULCHELLA

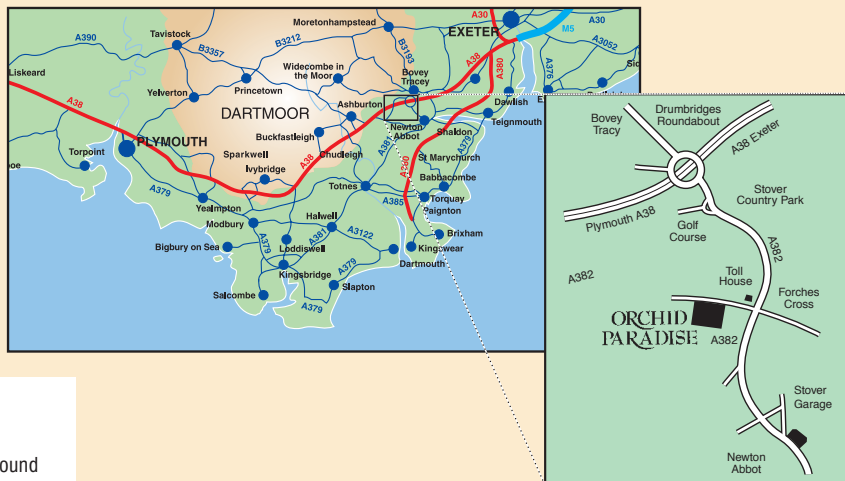
