Bulbophyllum

Bulbophyllums are a large group of orchids originating from mainly South East Asia and growing at lower, warmer altitudes, with some from Africa and South America too. They are quite variable in their flowers and growth habit making them a very diverse group to grow.



Temperature - Min. 18°C Max. 30°C

Light - Keep shaded from the brightest summer sun but in good light in winter.

Watering - Regularly water in summer and in winter give a little occasionally in order to keep the pseudobulbs plump. Some species continue to grow throughout the winter season.

Feeding - Feed with a Grow feed in spring/summer changing to Bloom feed in the autumn. Continue to feed any species that are still growing in winter.

Bark Type - Use a medium-coarse grade orchid bark for repotting.

Re-Potting - Repot when growing and making roots, after flowering.

Flowering - The season will vary between species.

Extra Info - Some bulbophyllum flowers are known for their unusual and sometimes pungent scent whilst others are nicely fragrant or no scent at all. The odorous ones are aiming to attract carrion flies to achieve pollination.

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
