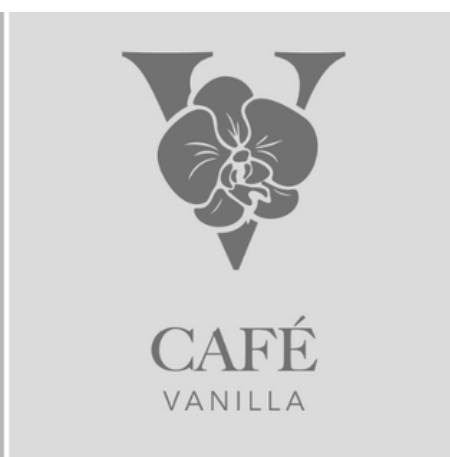

Feeding Your Orchids

Orchids are not heavy feeders as in nature nutrients are not readily available to them in the treetops; they are adapted to use what little they can find.

Therefore, in cultivation we keep the feeding of orchids very simple. We recommend Orchid Focus feeds which have been especially formulated for orchids. They are available in two types and should be used as follows:



Many orchids are seasonal and grow during the spring and summer months. These include cymbidiums, oncidiums, miltoniopsis, dendrobiums and coelogynes. For these orchids use **Orchid Focus 'Grow'** from the **start of February to the end of July**. This is high in nitrogen which helps leaf growth. Then from the **start of August to the end of November** use **Orchid Focus 'Bloom'**. This is high in potash and helps with the finishing of growth and development of flowers. Add feed to the water every 2-3 waterings, it can be poured through the compost and sprayed onto the leaves and roots. There is no need to feed through the winter.

Phalaenopsis are not seasonal, they grow and flower at any time of the year. Therefore **Orchid Focus 'Grow' and 'Bloom' can be used alternately** throughout the whole year every other watering as above.

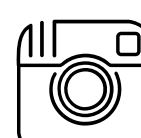
