Miltoniopsis & Miltonia

Miltoniopsis or “Pansy Orchids” are very showy and so called because of their large, flat, rounded, pansy-like flowers. They are often fragrant and come in a range of shades of pink, purple, red, white and occasionally yellow. The species come from Colombia.

Close relations the miltonias are from Brazil and need similar care.



Temperature - Min. 12°C Max. 25°C

Light - These orchids have soft, pale green leaves that need a shadier position than many other orchids.

Watering - They are easily overwatered and prone to rot so take care to water sparingly when in their growing season and mist more regularly to increase humidity instead.

Feeding - Feed with a Grow feed in spring/summer changing to Bloom feed in the autumn. No feed is needed in the winter.

Bark Type - Use a medium grade orchid bark for repotting.

Re-Potting - Repot after flowering with the new leaves and roots.

Flowering - The season is usually spring/summer.

Extra Info - Regular misting of the foliage will help prevent folding of the new leaves as they grow, in a concertina fashion. This occurs when the new leaves get too dry and stick together.
