Young Plants

We produce many varieties of young seedlings in our on-site laboratory. After about 2 years they are potted up ready for sale and then will need to be grown on for a further few more years to flowering. The time needed will vary from species to species. It is a fun way to add new plants to your collection and to enjoy the process of seeing them mature.



Temperature - Min. 10°C Max. 25°C but variable with the species.

Light - Shade from the bright summer sun but good light in winter.

Watering - Regularly water in summer and less in winter. Smaller pots can dry out more quickly so keep a close eye on them.

Feeding - Feed with a Grow feed in spring/summer changing to Bloom feed in the autumn to give them the potash they also need to grow well even though they are not yet large enough to make flowers.

Bark Type - Use a fine grade orchid bark whilst small and increase to a medium grade as they mature.

Re-Potting - Repot with the start of new leaf growth each year as they are increasing in size and then every 2-3 years when mature.

Flowering - Once they reach flowering size then they should flower in their correct season depending on species.

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
